## Richards submits verbal resignation; council talks sports complex

Hoopeston's Ward 1 needs a new representative to the city council,

At Tuesday night's council meeting, Mayor Jeff Wise announced that Kyle Richards verbally resigned from the council, citing time constraints and that he was unable to put in the time the council deserves.

While the resignation, made March 10, will not be official until Richards submits a signed, notarized letter of his intentions, Wise is asking those in Ward 1 interested in serving on the council to submit a letter to him at city hall.

By Hoopeston ordinance, Ward 1 is defined as "All that territory within the corporate limits of the city

lying south of the centerline of the Norfolk and Western Railroad right-of-way and west of the centerline of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad right-of-way declared to be the first ward."

Richards' absence leaves a hole in leadership for an upcoming skate jam and also McFerren Park Civic Center improvements. Wise said Ald. Kellie Ferrell will oversee the skate jam, and Ald. Rachelle Miller will head civic center improvements.

Wise said \$163,000 is available for improvements and that if officials want them done before this year's National Sweetcorn Festival, "We need to get moving."

In other business, the council approved the formation of a sports complex exploratory committee after Wise said he received suggestions from members of some sports groups that the city have a sports complex.

"I'm putting this on the shoulders of the parks committee," Wise said, adding he expects those interested in have a complex to eventually form a board and take it over.

Estimates Wise has seen range from \$200,000 to \$1 million. "I'm 100 percent behind it, but they're not cheap," he said, adding the city would do it right or not at all..
