Alive Inside to be presented by Rotary, Lorraine Foundation

Film focuses on music as help for those with dementia, Alzheimer's

Hoopeston Rotary Club and The Lorraine Foundation are partnering to present community screenings of *Alive Inside* on Wednesday April 19 at 6:30 p.m. and Saturday April 22 at 3 p.m. at The Little Lorraine, 214 E. Main Street, Hoopeston.

Alive Inside is the story of Dan Cohen, a small town social worker who discovers the power personalized music has to "awaken" and regenerate deeply locked memories in patients with dementia and Alzheimer's.

The film follows Cohen as he struggles to change the lives for those affected, and to make personalized music a standard of care in all 16,000 nursing homes in the US.

As an added bonus, after each screening, the film's writer and director Michael Rossato-Bennett will join the audience to discuss the film and answer questions.

"*Alive Inside* not only has helped change the lives of elders with dementia, but the way we view and approach them," Rossato-Bennett said. "Most of us are only one degree of separation away from someone with dementia, so it is up to all of us to make the world a better place for them. You are the change agent, as a teacher, a

parent or just a human with a heart. We all can play a part."

Alive Inside won the 2014 Sundance Audience Award in the US Documentary category.
