## Cleaning up

Construction workers labor into the lunch hour to clean up debris from the former Bzzz Place Thursday, using the vacant lot of the former Radio Shack to pile rubble. The burned out former bar has been an evesore at the corner of Main and Market since March 24, 2019 when a fire heavily damaged the structure. Work was stalled on demolition when the State Fire Marshal's office did not release a cause of the blaze. That was followed by litigation by the City of Hoopeston against owner Brian Swinford, of Danville. Eventually, Swinford agreed to have the building taken down and hired AJ Garrison, of Hoopeston, to do the work. Most recently, the west end of the 300 block of East Main was blocked for three weeks in preparation for the demolition/cleanup, which concluded Thursday. The incident also damaged the neighboring former office of the Hoopeston Chronicle, which the city has purchased and will seek demolition bids.
