morning. The cost is \$5 per person and all participants will get a Joe Cannon pin.

An open house will be held from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. at the Fithian Home, where Cannon artifacts will be on display. T-shirts honoring him will be on sale both Friday and Saturday.

Vermilion County took deed to the property in October 2022 and began the process of moving county offices from the Courthouse Annex to the new location.

Along with Shimkus, the National Park Service and General Services Administration assisted in transitioning ownership of the building, which was erected in 1911.

In December 2022, the county board approved changing the building's name to honor of Cannon, who represented the 15th Congressional District for almost 50 years and was Speaker of the House from 1803-1911.

Cannon, known as "The Tyrant of Illinois," also has a building that bears his name in Washington, D.C.: The Cannon House Office Building, completed in 1908, was named after him in 1962.
