Vermilion County Health Department to offer several free Narcan training sessions in May

Vermilion County Health Department is offering several free Narcan training sessions this month, beginning Wednesday, May 10. Training will be held from 5-6 p.m. at the health department, 200 S. College St., Danville. Additional training will be held May 16, 1-2 p.m.; May 17 5-6 p.m.; May 24, 1-2 p.m.; and May 26, 1-2 p.m.

Training will be held in the health department office conference room and is limited to 20 people per session.

The layman's Narcan training will teach participants how to recognize the signs of an opioid overdose and how to administer the opioid overdose reversal drug Naloxone.

The free session will also cover the effects of the opioid public health crisis in the U.S., how to recognize and prevent an opioid overdose and how to administer naloxone.
