Free Youth Mental Health First Aid training to be held June 17 at Hoopeston Multi Agency

A free program will be offered next month for parents, grandparents, teachers and others who interact with young people.

Youth Mental Health First Aid training will be held from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Saturday, June 17, at Hoopeston Multi Agency, 206 S. First Ave.

The program teaches participants how to identify, un-

derstand and respond to signs of mental health and substance use challenges among children and adolescents ages 12-18. Included in the training are:

- Common signs of mental health challenges in this age group, including anxiety, depression, eating disorders, and Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder.
- Common signs and symptoms of substance use chal-

lenges.

- How to interact with a child or adolescent in crisis.
- How to connect youth with help.
- Expanded content on trauma, substance use, self-care and the impact of social media and bullying.
