Illinois, federal government end COVID-19 related policies

Policies put in place for COVID-19 have been allowed to lapse at the state and federal levels.
 Gov. J.B. Pritzker on Thursday, formally issued a proclamation ending the Public Health Emergency declarations in place since March 9, 2020 and declaring May 11 'Illinois Public Health and Health Care Hero Day.'
 Gov. J.B. Pritzker, declaring a state emergency, issued dozens of executive orders, aligning Illinois' response with that of the federal government, allowing Illinois to receive as much federal help as possible.
 While many other states declared the emergency over earlier, Pritzker continued to follow federal guidelines "to ensure enhanced federal benefits in SNAP and Medicaid

remained in place for vulnerable families for as long as possible," according to a statement released after Pritzker spoke at a worker appreciation event in Springfield.
 During the emergency, daily tallies of new cases of the respiratory illness were announced daily by public health officials around the state.
 More recently, the state switched to a statewide map indicating county by county which were in low, medium or high rates of the coronavirus.
 Levels in the state remain at low levels, with an announcement last week that no Illinois counties were at an elevated community level for COVID-19, the press announcement said.
