Hoopeston man pleads guilty, sentenced to 10 years in IDOC

A Hoopeston man was sentenced Tuesday to 10 vears in the Illinois Department of Corrections after pleading guilty to two felony charges.

Skyler Burke, 34, was sentenced by Circuit Judge Charles Hall to 10 years for intimidation, a class 3 felony extended term, and three years for domestic battery, a class 4 felony, according to a press statement from Jacqueline Lacy, Vermilion County State's Attorney. Based on his guilty plea to domestic battery, Burke will be required to serve four years of mandatory supervised release (parole) after he is released from prison.

Judge Hall heard evidence that on December 23. Burke became irate with the mother of his children, possibly over diverging romantic interests, Lacy's statement said. The argument turned physical and Burke made threats of violence against the victim. threatening to escalate to even more, possibly deadly violence, if the police were contacted.

Hoopeston Police Department was contacted, arrived and saw Burke holding the victim against her will, then hit her. The victim broke free from Burke and got away. While he was being detained and arrested, Burke threatened revenge against the woman.

Lacy expressed her appreciation of the victim's courage in the case, including her family, and their prompt reporting of Burke's crimes. She also thanked Hoopeston Police Department for their efforts to ensure that "this domestic abuser will properly spend a significant period behind bars."
