combining magic with gospel stories, which expanded not only his repertoire, but also the audiences, such as church groups. Friday's show will not include gospel magic, he said.

Over the years, Shields has done educational programs, corporate shows, birthday parties and more. "I enjoy performing for people, getting them to laugh because I always include comedy with (the magic.)"

"The Amazing Randy Shields" has performed locally at Heritage Health, in Hoopeston Area schools for the Teen Reach program, and others.
