Burn ban issued in city, fireworks display postponed

The severe drought has caused Hoopeston officials to postpone Saturday's fireworks show and issue a burn ban until further notice. The ban includes lighting fireworks, which can cause grass fires.

Fire Chief Joel Bird and Police Chief Chris Kelnhofer attended Tuesday's Hoopeston City Council meeting to discuss the need for caution setting off fireworks. The

two were working on a plan for Saturday's fireworks.

Residents who disobey the ban and whose fireworks cause property damage will be charged accordingly.

It was just last July 3 when fireworks were blamed for a fire at the former Joan of Arc tomato factory. Several departments were on the scene until the early hours of July 4.
