**Board approves coaches' resignations, new staff for 2023-24**

A combination of life events has resulted in resignations from several Hoopeston Area Middle School coaches. At its June 15 meeting, the district board accepted resignations from Felipe Martinez, middle school track coach, effective May 24; Stephanie Pratt, softball, effective May 18; and Amber Wilson, cheer coach, effective May 24. After the meeting, Supt. Robert Richardson said the coaches are resigning "due to change in employment, family matters and work situation." Resignations were also accepted from Theresa Huls, Maple personal aide and Emily Coffee, PreK teacher. In other personnel action, the board approved hiring

Camille Unzicker as Pre-K teacher; Emily Hickman, first grade teacher; Courtney Nicholls, middle school aide. A motion to hire Marcella Noel as a long term sub for high school math was tabled. The board approved transferring Angie Simpson from classroom aide to middle school secretary for the coming school year. Trey Dugle was approved as a high school boys basketball volunteer pending approved background check.
