Paxton teens killed in Tuesday crash, no ID on other driver

Two Paxton teens have been identified as victims in Tuesday's fatal accident early Tuesday evening.

Vermilion County Coroner Jam McFadden identified the teens as Joseph D. Stallone, 19, and Keegynn L. Martinek, 17. Autopsies are scheduled for this week, McFadden said. The driver of the Camry that T-boned the teens' Jeep has not been identified, she said.

The accident occurred at 7:23 p.m. State Route 49 and 3350 North Rd., Rankin.

The accident continues to be investigated by Illinois State Police and McFadden's office.

A 17-year-old Hoopeston boy was arrested after police were called at 1:04 a.m. Wednesday to the 500 block of West Maple. The youth was charged with three counts of aggravated assault and disorderly conduct on a complaint from a 39-year-old Hoopeston woman.

The boy was taken to the Juvenile Detention Center in Danville.

Hunter Wright, 27, of Potomac was arrested after police tried to stop his vehicle for a traffic violation. The incident occurred at 4:47 p.m. Wednesday at Rtes. 1 and 9.

Police said when their emergency lights were activated, Wright fled the scene. He was apprehended on preliminary charges of two counts of aggravated flee-

ing and eluding, aggravated speeding +2 traffic control devices, violation of classification, aggravated reckless driving and unlawful display on a vehicle of any title documents.

Wright was taken to the Public Safety Building in Danville to await arraignment.
