Play about air guitar comes to the Lorraine Theatre Saturday

Acting, head-banging music and the 1980s phenomenon known as air guitar join forces as the Lorraine Theatre offers Airness at 7 p.m. Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday. Doors open an hour before each performance

The award-winning play was written by Chelsea Marcantel and will be presented by the KottrGrimm Theatrical Storytellers. The play is a comedy with music. Described as the best combination of rock concert, comfort show and theater performance. Airness, is a play about a young guitar player's introduction to the unique and intense world of competitive air guitar.
