Hoopeston contracts with county for animal control services

Stray cats and dogs will be taken to a new location after action taken by Hoopeston City Council at a special meeting Wednesday.

The council approved a contract with Vermilion County Animal Control in the wake of Sherry Klemme's resignation as humane officer.

Mayor Jeff Wise said Klemme resigned about a month ago, saying she did not have the time to continue in the position.

Klemme will still be active in Hoopeston Animal Rescue Team (HART).

With Klemme as humane officer, Hoopeston paid HART a fee to house the strays. Now the city will pay

Monthly kennel rent: \$25/mo.

Case billing: \$21 per case (welfare and cruelty investigations, injured domestic animal, stray animal, aggressive animals, animal bite cases, wildlife, police department assistance)

Impoundment for unclaimed animals: \$20 per animal (vaccinations for distemper, leptospirosis, rabies, bordetella, flea and tick treatment)

Board for unclaimed animals: \$20 per animal per day. 4-day max.

Euthanasia: \$50 per animal (unclaimed animals posing a risk to the public or public health)

Costs are subject to change only after discussion and agreement between the county and municipality receiving the service.
