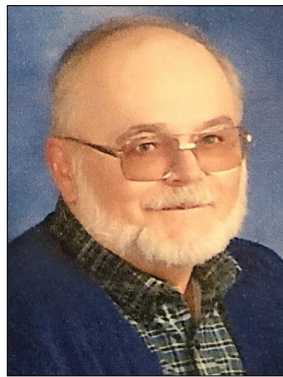
Obituaries
