WATSEKA—A Kankakee man is being held in the Iroquois County Jail on \$7 million bond after he was arrested in connection with double homicide in Watseka Thursday.

Scott E. Peterson, 44, of Kankakee, preliminary charges of two counts of first degree murder for each victim, 42-yearold Amanda Peterson and 38-year-old Joseph Robinson. The charges are Class M felonies.
