Milford man dies in early morning single-vehicle accident

A 24-year-old Milford man was killed in a single-vehicle accident Friday near Milford.

Tyler Fanning was killed in the accident, at 1:11 a.m. August 18 on 1050 N near 2540 E in rural Milford, according to a report from Iroquois County Sheriff's Police.

Mr. Fanning was eastbound on 1050 N when the 2013 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 he was driving left the roadway for unknown reasons. The vehicle entered the south ditch and traveled for about 242 feet before striking a field entrance. The vehicle then became airborne and traveled approximately 41 feet before hitting the ditch a second time, causing the truck to roll. The truck came to rest on its side near a culvert.

Open house set for Safe Routes plan

Hoopeston officials will hold an Open House regarding a proposed Safe Routes to School grant funded project. The event will be held 6-7 p.m. September 5 at Hoopeston City Hall, 301 W. Main St. The proposed project consists of new sidewalk along the west side of First Ave. between West Elm St. and West Orange St. (IL Route 9) and reconstruction of sidewalk along the north side of Orange (IL Route 9) from First Ave. to Fifth St.

These improvements will meet the American Disability Act requirements, to create a safe route to school for all students.
