# Hoopeston Area graduate returns to district as school nurse

Hoopeston Area graduate Maya Clemmons is returning to the district in a new role.

Clemmons, who graduated in 2012, was approved at the August 17 Hoopeston Area School Board meeting as the district nurse, pending approved background check and initiated EHR.

Having a school nurse was one item on the district's list of improvements officials wanted to see for this school year.

Clemmons was hired for the 2023-24 year and will serve all Hoopeston Area buildings.

In other personnel action:

- Rebecca Simonton and Shala Mills were approved as Maple personal aides, pending approved background check and initiated EHR.
- Maryna Zaitseva and Janice Manion were approved as bus aides, also pending background checks and initiated EHR.

The board also accepted Chris Small's resignation as middle school baseball volunteer and approved Bryce Leigh as middle/high school baseball volunteer and Zach Lingard and Dylan Mollet as high school football volunteers for the season, pending background checks.

In other business, the board approved several payments, including:

- •\$14,470 to PowerSchool for the Attendance Intervention Suite subscription for this school year.
- •\$41,284.82 to Project Success to begin programming for the new year. Funds are provided through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) III fund.
- •\$13,994 to radarsign to purchase two flashing beacon and flashing speed limit signs.
- •\$23,320 to TSI Commercial Floor Coverings to close out the middle school floor tile project.
- \$7,389 to Upchurch for preliminary design and construction documents and construction of the stadium bleachers.
- A \$10,630 quote from mobotrex for crosswalk lights and signage.
- \$246,804.52 and \$201,930.97 for payment requests one and two to Southern Bleacher Co., for installation of stadium bleachers.

In other business, the board approved PressPlus Policy Issue 112 updates, approved a Teacher Vacancy Grant Pilot Program application, and approved a spirit store Diversified Occupation position for this year.

## Hoopeston borrows donation idea from northern corn event

When it comes to celebrating sweet corn in Illinois, Hoopeston's National Sweetcorn Festival, at 79, is the matriarch of communities that honor one of American's favorite vegetables.

Being the matriarch is an achievement, but Hoopeston's celebration is not above borrowing an idea from a younger version.

This year, Hoopeston Javcees are trying out a new fundraising idea: a 50/50 raffle where one lucky donor will split the pot equally with the organization.

The idea was tried at the Mendota Sweet Corn Festival, which just celebrated its 76th year. Sponsored by the Mendota Chamber of Commerce, in 2022, the chamber and lucky donor split the \$42,240 pot.

Tickets for 50/50 Raffle on sale now and are \$1 each or six for \$5 or 30 for \$20. The drawing will be held on Labor Day and the winner need not be present

Tickets are available at Fast Lanes, The Burger Bank, and Fun for All Miniature Golf.

Another means of raising funds to help with festival expenses was started last year and is back again.
