Road closed for hours after unidentified driver does U-turn, dumps combine on Route 1

Route 1 at Bismarck Road was closed for approximately three hours after a semi driver dumped a combine on the road.

The accident occurred at about 4:30 p.m. August 29 when the unidentified driver slowed his tractor/flatbed trailer at Bismarck Road. Witnesses to the incident said they thought the driver was going to turn onto Bismarck Road, but it soon became clear that the driver was attempting a U-turn.

According to a report from Illinois State Police Troop

Witnesses reported that once the combine was off of the flatbed, the trailer righted itself.
