Skate Jam 2023 to raise funds for skate park improvements

The Complex, Hoopeston's skate park in McFerren Park, will host Skate Jam 2023 from noon-5 p.m. Saturday.

The event will be a family affair, with bounce houses, kids games, DJ, vendors and more.

Skateboarding contests will be held, with registration starting at 10 a.m. Open skate will be held from 10 a.m.-noon, with contests beginning at noon. Trophies will be presented to the winners.

There is a \$10 participant fee and a \$5 spectator bracelet. All proceeds will go into the skate park for safety fencing, expansion, ramps, rails, lighting and other improvements/equipment, said April Jones.

In June, Jones addressed Hoopeston City Council, requesting the skating area be expanded by 10' east and 10' north, and put a fence around the area to keep small children from running to the skate park when it is in use.

"Everyone (is) welcome," she said. "We would like the support of our community as well. Even if you don't skate, we encourage you to come check out the talent in Skateboarding and support our local skate park right here in Hoopeston."

A skate jam that was scheduled for August 5 got rained out, but Saturday's event will go on, rain or shine. In case of inclement weather, the jam will be moved inside. Jones said.
