Hoopeston to hold used tire collection Saturday at annex

Hoopeston residents will have a chance to get rid of used tires at no cost.

A free used tire collection will be held from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday at the McFerren Park Annex.

The collection will be for Hoopeston residents only. The program is available to all Vermilion County municipalities. Residents of other communities may contact their elected officials to see if their communities are participating.

Other criteria for the collection includes:

- No tires larger than car/truck/SUV tires.
- Tires on rims will be allowed.
- Limit of six tires per vehicle.
- Those bringing tires must load their own tires onto the trailer provided. Bring abled-bodied people to unload the tires onto the trailer.

Those rules are more like guidelines, however, according to Ald. Kellie Ferrell, chairman of the city's civic improvement committee. Anyone with the following is asked to call Ferrell at (217) 597-5760:

- Bigger tires than what are being accepted. Ferrell said she may be able to set something up where those with larger tires can, at a later date, follow those running the city collection to the drop-off location. Call
- Those who have slightly more than six tires but not an entire trailer load - may be allowed to drop them off. Call first.

For those unable to bring someone to help, help will be provided onsite, she said.


