Hoopeston Area schools celebrate, honor local veterans

Hoopeston Area students and staff, along with residents, turned out Friday to show honor to local veterans at the school's Veterans Day program.

High School Principal John Klaber welcomed attendees to the event, which began at 9 a.m. Friday in the Hoopeston Area Middle School gym.

Hoopeston American Legion, under the direction of Bob Duffin, presented the colors and the high school band played The National Anthem. Middle school student council members Caleb Clark. Chanel Howie and Khloe Brewer led the assemblage in the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Following the Pledge, the John Greer Chorus sang "We Honor You," followed by Alleyna Zamora presenting the student essay. The middle school and high school choruses then presented "Song for the Unsung Hero," followed by the high school band's rendition of "America the Beautiful."

Marine Jeannie Long gave the day's keynote speech and all veterans attending were asked to stand as the song for each branch of the military was played by the high school band during "Armed Forces on Parade."

A video tribute to local servicemen through the years, created by Tim Walsh and Zach Colleen, was shown, followed by Mail Call, where veterans attending the service received letters of support written by students.

After 30 seconds of silence, Taps was played. Klaber then gave closing remarks.

Later Friday, Hoopeston VFW served a free ham & beans meal to area veterans and on Saturday, Veterans Day, Hoopeston American Legion served free chili to the local heroes at The Legion.
