Hoopeston Planning Commission hears zoning requests

Hoopeston Planning Commission and Zoning Board discussed three requests for changes at a meeting on De-

Bill Nicholls, representing Hoopeston Land Improvements, Inc., attended the meeting to ask that the Little League fields be separated from the rest of the former Vermilion Iron property.

"At some time, we want to do something with that site," he said, but right now, the group would like ball fields spun off and be placed either under the control of the sports organization or the city. Nicholls prefers the city have control because of the continuity it can provide.

Commission Chairman Cody Moore said some of the

sports property, including the out field and concessions area, are already on city property.

The matter was set to be discussed again at a public hearing on December 13.

The second request came after a house at 112 N. Third St. was sold to new owners. The property is zone R-3, but according to codes, that zone is for lots 6,000 sq. ft., or larger. The lot in question is 5,518 sq. ft. Moore said he discussed the matter with Mayor Jeff Wise and Steve Miller, city attorney, who said a variance would have to be granted to grandfather it in.


