## New year, new rules - more than 300 new laws in Illinois

An increase in the minimum wage and paid time off for all Illinois workers are just two of more than 300 laws that go into effect in Illinois on January 1, 2024.

Minimum wage will increase to \$14 per hour, starting January 1. The hike is part of a law signed in 2019 that increases the minimum wage to \$15 per hour starting in

The change applies to most workers 18 and older. Pay for teens working less than 650 hours in a calendar year will increase to \$13 an hour. The minimum wage for tipped workers will increase to \$9 per hour.

Another employment-related change was approved during January's lame duck session. The Paid Leave for All Workers Act requires most employers to provide 40

hour of paid time off per year to workers, and allows employees to request days off with only seven days' notice. For unplanned absences which could not be foreseen, the request needs to be "as soon as possible."

The law also bans employers from requiring or asking employees to find replacements for them if they take time off. Employers are also prohibited from discriminating against workers to take time off by cutting their hours or not giving them opportunities for advancement.

Another law passed in January's lame duck session requires residents who own guns, ammunition and accessories classified in the state's "assault weapons" ban to register those items with the state. The law is expected to eventually go to the U.S. Supreme Court, although a federal judge last week declined to temporarily halt the law's enforcement and the U.S. high court also declined to stay the law. The Democrat-majority Illinois Supreme Court upheld the law in a 4-3 ruling in August.

Other laws approved this year that take effect January 1, 2024 include:

- It is now illegal for drivers to videoconference or checking social media pages while driving.
- Utilities are banned from shutting off gas or electric services due to nonpayment when temperatures exceed 90 degrees or a heat advisory is in effect.
- High school students will now be taught the dangers of fentanyl in state-required health courses.
