Ryan Anderson's tractor for pulling contests has been made into a 1/16 replica to raise money in honor of his late father.

The super farm tractor, Check'n Out, replica was specially created by Justin Stuckenschneider, owner of Stuckenschneider Custom Replicas, of Benton City, Mo., for the 2024 Midwest Winter Nationals Farm Toy Show.

Raffle tickets may be purchased online at www.zeffy.com until January 8. After that, tickets will be sold at the nationals, held January 11-13 at Shipshewana, Ind.

Tickets are one for \$10, three for \$20 or 20 for \$100. The winner will be drawn the evening of January 13.


