Owen Root scored 23 points and grabbed five rebounds to lead Hoopeston Area to a 77-27 road trip victory over Schlarman on January 9. Also in double digits were Wyatt Eisenmann with 20 and Trenton Montez with 13.

Root was 3 of 4 for three-point shots, while Eisenmann was 2 of 4. Dylan Deck contributed one from uptown, as well.

Rounding out scoring, Ethan Steiner had eight, Nick Cardenas four, and Dylan Judy, Zach Huchel and Mason Rush had two each.

Root's 20 points Wednesday and home court advantage were not enough to lift the team to win, losing 68-52 to Oakwood.

Rush was 3 of 7 for three-pointers with Montez 1 of 2 toward their respective totals of 11 and 10. Eisenmann had five points and Kendrick Sigerill four, with Steiner adding two.

Eisenmann and Rush had four rebounds each, while Root, Montez and Sigerill each had three.

The loss put the team at 13-6 overall and notched their first loss of the season in the Vermilion Valley Conference, stading at 4-1.

The Cornjerker JV team also lost, 58-33. Dylan Judy had nine points and Brayden Walder and Nick Cardinas had seven each.

HA freshmen won their match, 40-19, with Jaquen Lewis snagging 12 points and Felix Cantu eight.
