grams that are changing lives and making a difference in the co-op's 10-county service area.

The award was announced in the EIEC Power Lines newsletter this month. A story on the Multi Agency detailed its history, including when it moved from an office in the former City National Bank building to its current location in what had been the Chronicle-Herald office, at 206 S. First Ave. The building had been donated to the Eastern Illinois Multi Purpose Center and in 1995, IMPC merged with the Multi Agency.

Along with the emergency food pantry, the Multi Agency offers space for counseling and other services and activities, provides in-town transportation and social events, such as the monthly Senior Citizen Dinner/Dance.

Projects awarded by EIEC/CoBank can cover a wide area. For example, in December, EIEC awarded Iroquois County Goat Producers \$5,000 to enhance the new goat barn at the Iroquois County Fairgrounds.
