City to consider hen ordinance

At its meeting Tuesday, Hoopeston City Council is expected to consider an ordinance that would allow residents to raise female chickens.

Ald. Kellie Ferrell presented aldermen with the proposed ordinance at the March 5 meeting, saying she would bring it up for a vote this week.

Under the proposal, the law would be required to be in a coop or run and not allowed to run at large. They may be allowed to exercise in a back yard with a 6' or taller fence, with supervision. Coops and runs would be located in the back of residences, not in the front or side yards, and must be 6' off of the property line and 20' from any neighboring dwelling. Coops would need to provide a minimum of four sq. ft. of floor area per hen.

A permit would be required to have chickens. The \$10 permit would automatically renew annually at no extra cost as long as the owner has complied with the ordinance.
