District 1 to have contest for Vermilion County Board seat

Northern Vermilion County residents will have a choice to make November 5 on who will represent District 1 of the Vermilion County Board.

Both Republican incumbent Todd Johnson and Democrat challenger Amy Buttram ran unopposed in Tuesday's general primary election.

Johnson received 575 votes, 12 percent of the 4,782 eligible voters. Buttram received 92 votes in the highly Republican district.

Incumbent committeemen Joel Bird and Ryan Goodner were reelected to represent Grant 2 and Grant 4, respectively.
