Hoopeston, Vermilion County recycling collections Saturday

Hoopeston and Vermilion County will have electronics recycling events Saturday.

Thomas Electronics Recycling will be at the McFerren Park Annex from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturday for the mostly free collection. All electronics will be accepted free except for the following:

- Wood, projection or broken televisions \$30
- Tube televisions \$25
- Flat screen televisions and tube monitors \$5 Cash in the exact amount only will be accepted.

Hen ordinance approved

Hoopeston City Council on Tuesday approved an ordinance allowing female chickens in the city. Females of other fowl and all male fowl are banned.

The issue was set to be voted on March 19 meeting but was tabled after Ald. Kellie Ferrell, civic improvement committee head, received input on the original proposal.

The ordinance outlines where coops and runs may be located, required floor space for hens, handling and disposal of manure.

The ordinance includes a one-time permit fee. Permits will renew annually with no further fee as long as the


