Local sky watchers to have good view of Monday's eclipse

It's been said that close is only good in horseshoes and hand grenades. And sometimes solar eclipses.

While Hoopeston will not be in the area of totality, according to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Eclipse Explorer, Hoopeston will have 98.2 percent totality at 2:06 p.m. Monday. The eclipse will begin at 12:29 p.m. and end at 3:21 p.m. The percent of totality in the 2017 eclipse was 91 percent.

In Illinois, Carbondale will have complete totality, as it did in 2017. Indianapolis, Ind., will also have complete totality.

To view the eclipse, experts stress that people should not look at the sun during the eclipse. Special solar glasses may be worn, or homemade devices, like a pinhole projector, can be used safely (eclipse.aas.org) Telescopes with special features may be used, but using cameras or cell phones may damage the devices.

Also, studies by Rick Feinberg of the American Astronomical Society, published in the September 2021 issue of the Astronomical Journal, support the safety of welders filter shades 12, 13, and 14. These all safely allow 6.9 hours of continuous sun viewing. But no lower number

Have you ever wondered how to read weather formations?


Want information on what a storm spotter does?

A solar eclipse occurs when the moon passes between the earth and sun. Although considered somewhat rare, total solar eclipses occur about every 18 months in various parts of the world.

totality plan to use the eclipse as a learning experience. In a statement issued Friday, Hoopeston Area Supt. Robert Richardson said the district would not view the event as an official learning unit of instruction. Parents who want to pick up their children to view the eclipse are asked to send a note to notify the office of the time the child will be picked up, and the absence would be excused.

The next solar eclipses occur in America will occur August 23, 2044, followed on one on August 12, 2045, which will have the longest totality in U.S. history, at six minutes.
