With his wife and daughters in the front row, John Greer Principal Dan Walder reads a statement on his career in the Hoopeston Area district at a special Hoopeston Area School Board meeting Monday evening. The meeting was called after Walder was investigated by Supt. Robert Richardson, and an unspecified number of school board members, for complaints against Walder from unidentified John Greer staff alleging he is sexist, gives staff the silent treatment and does not trust staff, among others. Some of the nearly 100 people who attended the nearly four-hour long meeting refuted those claims and spoke highly of Walder's leadership, empathy, humility and dedication to students, parents and staff. The board did not vote to pursue disciplinary action against Walder.
