

A line of storms on June 5 strengthened as it went through Vermilion County on June 5. An EF-1 tornado developed south of East Lynn, touching down about three miles south of the town, along E 3800 North Rd. Seven grain bins, some pictured above, were completely destroyed and debris spread about a half mile to the east/northeast. Two power poles were also snapped. As the tornado moved east, then northeast, it damaged trees, home siding and the roof of an outbuilding along N 770 East Rd., then damaged trees at a residence about half a mile to the north before weakening.
