# Accident in rural Milford claims life of Hoopeston woman

Hoopeston is mourning a Hoopeston woman who was a lover of animals and who has been the face of the local McDonald's for decades.

Sara Rhodes, 64, of Hoopeston, was pronounced dead at the scene of the accident Wednesday at the intersection of County Road 2000 East and County Road 1000 North in rural Milford.

According to a report from the Iroquois County Sheriff's Office, Ms. Rhodes, in a 2017 Chrysler Pacifica, was southbound on County Road 2000 East.

The report stated that for unknown reasons, she failed to stop at the marked intersection, entered the intersection and struck a westbound 2014 Peterbilt semi-tractor, driven by Sebastian Lade, 32, of Mil-

The collision caused both vehicles to leave the road and enter the ditch on the southwest side of the intersection, causing the semi-tractor to overturn, according to the report.

Lade was treated for minor injuries and was released on scene.

Iroquois County Sheriff's Police were assisted on scene by Milford Fire Protection District, Milford EMS, an Illinois State Police Reconstruction Team and Iroquois County Coroner's office.

The accident remains under investigation.


