City, Kirby Foods work to get new golf cart path at plaza

For some motorists, you couldn't always get there from here but now you can.

Last week, Hoopeston Street and Alley Department personnel created an entrance path just for golf carts at Hoopeston Plaza. The path runs west off of West Elm straight into the shopping center parking lot on the Kirby

Mayor Jeff Wise said discussion about such a path had been going on for about a year, starting with a complaint about people illegally driving their cars across private property to get to the plaza. Stop and Do Not Enter signs were posted and ignored. The complaints continued this summer.

A short conversation after a planning commission meeting prompted Wise to contact Kirby Foods Manager Lucas Switzer last month. Switzer took the request to the corporate office where it was approved. "We think the path will definitely help out our customers that come to Kirby Foods and to the businesses on this side of Hoopeston," he said.

One of the selling points made to Kirby Foods was that there would be no cost to them for the project. Wise said there was little cost to the city, as the surface is asphalt millings the city already had. City employees dug out the grass, poured the millings and packed them. "Other than taking a day of labor and adding (Golf Cart Only) signs, there was no additional cost," he said. Future costs will be minimal, as the city will maintain the path, he added.

Switzer is looking forward to another plaza improvement. Kirby Foods has submitted a request to replace the store's parking lot. Once approved and completed, "that will make the golf cart path look that much better!"
