Officials expected to vote on increasing infrastructure fee

Hoopeston City Council is set to vote Tuesday on whether to increase the infrastructure maintenance fee to pay for water and sewer improvements.

Currently at \$10 per month, a suggested schedule would increase the fee to \$12 per living unit effective January 1, 2025 and \$19 per living unit effective May 1, 2025. The next increase would become effective May 1, 2026, to \$26, followed on May 1, 2027 to \$33 and May 1, 2028 to \$40 per month.

According to the resolution containing details of the increase, the city has upgraded both the water treatment and wastewater treatment plans and replaced about three blocks of water main along Market St., causing additional debt to the city and ultimately, to taxpayers.

Hoopeston officials have, since 1999, tried to put money aside for infrastructure maintenance. In 1999, the fee was \$3 per month and was placed in the general fund. In 2013, the then-council approved a five percent increase for five years to go into the fund and

in 2015, the amount was raised to \$5 per unit per month. That council rescinded putting the money into the general fund and instead created an account for the purpose.

Last year, the council approved spending \$6,450 per year on Waterworth, a software program designed to "optimize their water and wastewater rates, funding and infrastructure," according to the company's website. The program analyzes data to determine current and future spending needs, allowing municipalities to budget accordingly.

Based on the data, aldermen raised basic water and sewer rates by 25 percent last year, to a total of \$9.65 per month on the typical 5,000 gallon user. Waterworth calculated a 20 percent increase was needed this year and a two percent increase per year in subsequent years.




