Watseka teacher arrested after students allege grooming

A Hoopeston woman is being held in the Iroquois County Jail on charges of grooming and distributing harmful material after allegations that she made inappropriate comments to students at Watseka High School.

Baylee Bushong, 23, an agri-business teacher at Watseka Junior High School and Watseka High School, was arrested Thursday, October 10, after Watseka Police conducted "a short investigation" into the allegations, which police were notified of on October 8.
