### Ryder to be inducted into state track/cross country hall of fame

A former Hoopeston coach will be inducted in the 2025 Illinois Track and Cross Country Coaches Association Hall of Fame in January.

Quentin Ryder has been nominated for the honor, one of eight new inductees to be honored during the annual ITCCCA Hall-of-Fame Banquet on Saturday January 11, 2025 at Eaglewood Resort in Itasca.

Long known as one of the premier coaches in the Illiana

area, Quentin Ryder started the boys cross country program at Hoopeston High School in 1967, and coached the boys team at both Hoopeston High School and Hoopeston -East Lynn High School for 33 seasons. He started the girls cross country program at Hoopeston-East Lynn High School in 1983, and coached the girls' teams for 17 seasons.

In 39 total seasons of coaching track and field, 35 were spent at Hoopeston. In boys track and field, he was an assistant coach for 14 seasons and head coach for eight seasons. He then became girls head coach for 10 seasons

and finished his track career at Hoopeston as assistant girls coach for three seasons. He capped his career in track and field as an assistant girls' coach for four seasons at Lena-Winslow High School.

While an assistant track & field coach at Hoopeston-East Lynn, alongside head coach Dick Hobbs and fellow assistant Bob Doty, he helped guide the Cornjerkers to a second place team finish in the 1975 IHSA State Track meet. Throughout his track & field coaching career, Cornjerker athletes won two individual IHSA State Meet titles and two IHSA State Meet relay championships, with a total of 25 IHSA All-State medals earned.

As head coach of the Cornjerker harriers, he guided his 1979 Boys Cross Country team to a third place finish at the IHSA State Cross Country finals. He twice coached the individual runner-up at the IHSA State finals and his athletes earned IHSA All-State honors on eight occasions.

When he retired, his 311 dual meet wins in cross country at Hoopeston and Hoopeston-East Lynn were the all-time record for career wins in the state of Illinois and his 22 dual meet wins in the 1975 season at Hoopeston-East Lynn was the all-time state record for most dual meet wins in one season. He also garnered one undefeated season, going 17-0 in 1972.
