Contest entries are now being accepted to rename the Coliseum on the Illinois State Fairgrounds in Springfield. The contest runs through December 14. The winner will be selected by the Illinois Fairgrounds Foundation and the Illinois Department of Agriculture (IDOA) and announced in early January.

Current members of Illinois 4-H, FFA, and the Junior Horseman's Council are eligible to submit naming ideas to the contest. Each member is allowed one entry and can submit it online at [www.ilfairfoundation.com](http://www.ilfairfoundation.com). The winner will receive a silver platter of recognition

and an Illinois State Fair Mega Pass. The winner could also be a guest of honor at the grand re-opening of the Coliseum and serve as a youth fair marshal during the 2019 Illinois State Fair.

"Agriculture is an integral part of our state's identity, and the Illinois State Fairgrounds play an important part in promoting our agriculture industry," said Gov. Bruce Rauner. "Our youth in agriculture, including 4-H and FFA members, are the future of this industry, so it's only right that we let them name the historic building that will be open for generations to come."
