## Balloon event to military, feature archery team demonstration

Entering the grounds of the Vermilion Regional Airport on Friday, July 13, for the third annual Balloon Over Vermilion, guests will be greeted with hundreds of American flags lining Bowman Avenue and the terminal drive at Vermilion Regional Airport, placed by the Patriot Guard Riders. "We want to show our appreciation for those who serve and have served our great country," said Jim Anderson, event co-chair.

The patriotic theme continues in Friday's opening ceremony at 6 p.m. featuring the world-renowned voice of Chicago Blackhawks tenor Jim Cornelison singing the National Anthem. Cornelison is a multi-talented singer who has set the gold standard across the country with his powerful, legendary, traditional rendition of our nation's most iconic tune.

"You don't want to miss this exceptional talent right here in our own back yard" said Pat O'Shaughnessy event co-chair. "If you aren't familiar with him, he has many videos on You Tube and his web site is [Jimcornelison.com](http://Jimcornelison.com)" added O'Shaughnessy.

A Texan T-6 warbird flown by Jay Schroeder will soar overhead immediately following the anthem. First responders and the American Legion Riders motorcycle club will lead the Parade of Pilots as they take the field and prepare for a mass ascension of more than 30 hot air balloons. The balloons will return for a massive glow and

the evening's grand finale will feature a new spectacular laser light show.

On Saturday, another brand new activity to the 2018 festival line-up. Schlarman Academy's archery team will host a hands-on demonstration of shooting skills, equipment introduction, target sighting and the opportunity to shoot a bow yourself from 2-5 pm. Event-goers can even experience competition style marksmanship firing alongside Schlarman Academy's sharp shooting athletes.

Schlarman's 44 member co-ed team consists of both elementary and high school students. A relatively new sport to the Hilltoppers, archery was introduced seven years ago and they have been crowned state champions three of those seven years. In this year's national competition, Schlarman placed 44<sup>th</sup> out of 237 high school teams. "We are really excited to share our passion and love of this growing sport during Balloons Over Vermilion this year," said Tina Quick, a Schlarman Academy coach.

Other Saturday events include a classic car show hosted by the Illiana Antique Auto Club, Sand Volleyball tournament and Balloon School. Balloons Over Vermilion offers two full days of family friendly fun featuring live music, kids zone, helicopter and tethered balloon rides, balloon flights, dazzling balloon glows plus tons of great food and beverages.
